# **Commercial Space for Lease**



#### 718 SW Adams St.

Commercial space available in the heart of the Warehouse District! The two properties located right across from Dozer Park recently sold, and the new owner is ready to lease this prime space.

Property features: 3,300 SF (\$6.50 PSF – NNN) flex building set up with a small office/ retail area up front with the remainder mostly open warehouse space in the rear with a dark room previously used for photography, a storage room, and a small mezzanine above for additional storage - this area can be removed so the warehouse is wide open; one overhead drive-in door in the rear with a few parking spaces available on the ramp; large skylight offers abundant natural light; floor drains available in warehouse area; 13.6 FT ceiling height.



#### 720 SW Adams St.

Right next door to 718 SW Adams St. is 720 SW Adams with 5,500 SF (\$6.50 PSF – NNN) and is set up entirely as open warehouse space; approximately 12-foot ceilings with an overhead drive-in door directly off Adams street; Full 5,500 SF basement available with an additional 16 x 10 overhead door in the rear; poured concrete floors allow for vehicles to pull directly into the building on the main level as well as the lower level; 3-phase electrical power.

720 SW Adams is available for lease individually or as a package along with 718 SW Adams. Total combined available SF is 8,700 SF. Picture this: a fresh façade on both buildings and new storefront windows with an updated open concept interior for street-level retail space right across from the ballpark! Owner is willing to renovate the buildings to suit a tenant's needs.

# **City Updates**

#### PNC Building, Creve Coeur Building, and Parking Deck



The City of Peoria has officially invited developers to submit proposals for redevelopment of the historic, 11-story PNC Bank Building, Creve Coeur Building, and adjoining parking deck in downtown Peoria. On April 30th, officials issued a request for qualifications, which begins the process of vetting developers who are interested in undertaking the redevelopment of the three downtown properties.

The City of Peoria bought the three buildings — located at 301 SW Adams St., 304 SW Jefferson St. and 312 SW Jefferson St. — from Cullinan Properties last fall with the intent to sell to a developer interested in breathing new life into the properties that are viewed as vital to downtown development.

When asked for comment, DDC President/CEO Chris Waible said the "PNC Building is in a good location near the Civic Center and has an attached parking garage, making

it a nice redevelopment opportunity for a potential investor. I think more than anything the building is underutilized right now, so seeing some more life and activity in this location, this property, is a priority for the DDC," Waible said. "That could include residential; it could include a mix of uses."

# **Green Infrastructure Restoration Begins**



Beginning this month, restoration work will start throughout the City's numerous green infrastructure areas and native prairies. Work will include the removal of soil and plant material, soil amendments, and planting. We are happy to report that work will begin in the Warehouse District, specifically, in the planter boxes along:

- SW Washington Street from Maple Street to Liberty Street.
- SW Adams Street from Maple Street to Walnut Street.
- Oak Street from SW Jefferson Avenue to SW Washington Street.
- State Street from SW Adams Street to SW Water Street.

Spring into the 70's at Matilda's Cocktail Lounge in the Warehouse District at 100 State Street. This is such a unique little spot with a throwback to Grandma's living room in the 1970's. Pull up a chair, play a board game, read a book, or simply relax with a cocktail or mocktail in hand. Grab a crocheted Afghan if you feel a little chilly. Owner Whitney Calvert opened Matilda's last November and explained, **"The name Matilda's was inspired by the street my grandmother and aunt used to live on when I** was growing up. They lived directly across from each other on Matilda Street. It was a home away from home and a place to feel loved no matter what, which is what we hope Matilda's can be for you. I know we are sentimental at Matilda's but feeling at home and comfortable is everything." According to their Facebook page, they are introducing a new menu that will be "outside the box," of crayons maybe?! It sounds colorful and will pair well with those delicious drinks they conjure up. Their signature cocktail is the "Rubber Ducky" made with Gin, lemon, peach and mango V8, but easily as delicious without alcohol or made with a substitute nonalcoholic spirit. Many of the signature drinks were intentionally made to be enjoyed without alcohol or with a substitute. They also have a selection of hot teas, root beer floats, milkshakes, Mexican coke and flavored soda waters.

#### Wheel Art Pottery



Wheel Art Pottery Studio is a ceramic art/pottery school located in downtown Peoria at 1101 SW Washington Street. It is owned by Master Potter Jacob Grant, who has 25+ years' experience working in the clay/ceramic medium. According to Jacob, "When you come to Wheel Art Pottery Studio, not only do you learn how to make pottery from a true master, but you also get to learn about the interesting science behind clay and how it becomes a finished ceramic product that is truly functional." Wheel Art Pottery Studio makes all of its own clay and glazes in house, from recipes created by Jacob Grant. All Pottery created at Wheel Art Pottery Studio is food safe, dishwasher safe, and microwave safe.

This will be the 13th year for the summer clay and art class, led by instructors Jacob Grant and Kyla Cadwell. In a fun and entertaining way, campers will learn some science about what clay is, where it comes from, how it becomes a finished ceramic object, and what it means for a pot to be truly "functional." Campers will also take hikes through the Peoria Warehouse District where they will learn about the relevance of these buildings to Peoria's rich history and the significance of Peoria itself. Dozer Park, originally O'Brien Field and formerly Chiefs Stadium, is a baseball field located in downtown Peoria in the Warehouse District. It is the home of the Peoria Chiefs, the Midwest League affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals. The Peoria Chiefs have completed a major renovation of Dozer Park, including extending the safety netting to protect fans from foul balls. New batting cages have been added, and updates were made to the club houses and video rooms. After the 2025 season, the entire field will be replaced as part of the multi-million dollar renovation.

The 2025 season is in full swing, and we have included the schedule below. With over 40 home games through August 31st, there is ample opportunity to come out to the ballpark.
