After five years of sustained occupancy at Winkler Lofts (733 SW Washington Street in Peoria, IL), the Winkler family has added 36 new loft apartments and up to 12,000 square feet of commercial space in their Winkler Place development next door at 725 SW Washington. interest in the history and contributions of our people and organizations.
